I read with interest the comprehensive report on the findings of the Transformation Programme Phase One Consultation. As you know, I have considerable concerns about the consultation process, many of which are reiterated in your report. I am also conscious that HOSC has not had the opportunity to complete its scrutiny role in advance of the publication of the report. Given that Oxfordshire MPs are meeting next week, hopefully we will have the opportunity to discuss these points then.

In the meantime, I would welcome reassurance that the entire Board will be made aware of the content of the ongoing judicial review brought by five councils at the meeting on Tuesday. It would also be helpful to have a clear timetable from the Clinical Commissioning Group about its Phase One decision-making process and plans for Phase Two. I appreciate that the Board will be meeting on 10 August, but presumably they will be given a further report with recommendations to consider in advance of this? If so, when will this be made available?

Any further clarification you can provide regarding the anticipated timeline would be much appreciated.
